Hatherden Farm Venue Terms & Conditions

Here at Hatherden Farm we have tried to make our terms of business as simple as possible. If however you have any questions please feel free to speak to us.

Your event must adhere to the following conditions laid out in the premises license, licensing act 2003 for Hatherden Farm.

The venue must be vacated by 00:30.

We require notice of the number of guests who will be onsite at your event to ensure that numbers do not exceed the maximum capacity as set by Health and Safety and Fire Regulations.

Smoking is not permitted within The Old Dairy under any circumstances. Smoking is permitted outside the building and guests must ensure that cigarettes are extinguished before returning to the building.

The Old Dairy must receive any complaints in writing no more than seven days after the date of the venue booking.

When leaving the premises all guests must be considerate to local residents and leave the premises as quietly as possible.

No bouncy castles or similar on or in the premises.

No fireworks or Chinese Lanterns.

Music must finish at 12 midnight.

The venue has a noise restriction notice, accordingly all recorded music must not be played above a decibel level set by Test Valley Borough Council.

Live music can only be played outside if it is unamplified and must finish by 5pm.

Windows and doors of the function room must be closed at all times while entertainment is ongoing.

Alcohol sales must finish by 23:30.

The premises are fully licensed. See our list of recommended bars listed on our links page.

Alcohol must only be consumed on the premises.

Private gardens and swimming pool can be used for photography purposes only at couples' own risk.

Rooms to be vacated by midday.

There is a challenge 25 policy operating at the premises. Challenge 25 means that the holder of the premises license (Hatherden Farm) shall insure that every individual who visually appears to be under 25 and wants to purchase alcohol must produce identification, proving the individual is 18 years or older. The venue hirer should ensure all guests are aware of these terms.

The Old Dairy reserves the right to cancel a reservation. In the unlikely event that your booking is canceled, you will be refunded any advance payments including deposits, but will have no further liability whatsoever. We will only have to cancel if any part of the venue is closed or unavailable due to events beyond our control, if you, or we, become insolvent, or in the case of a bankruptcy petition, or if The Old Dairy premises license is withdrawn.

The balance is due 8 weeks prior to the Wedding Date £5,500.00.
